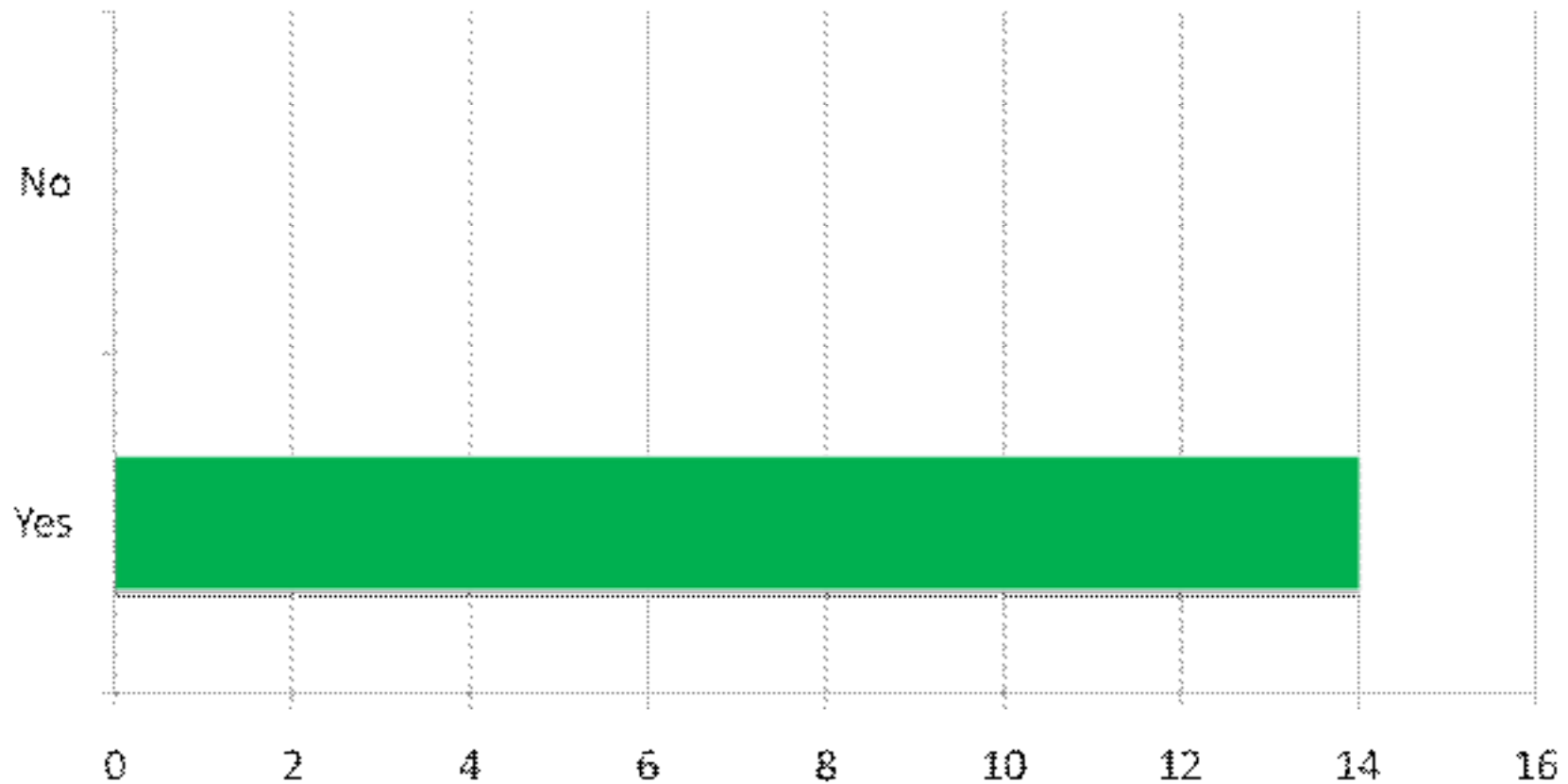

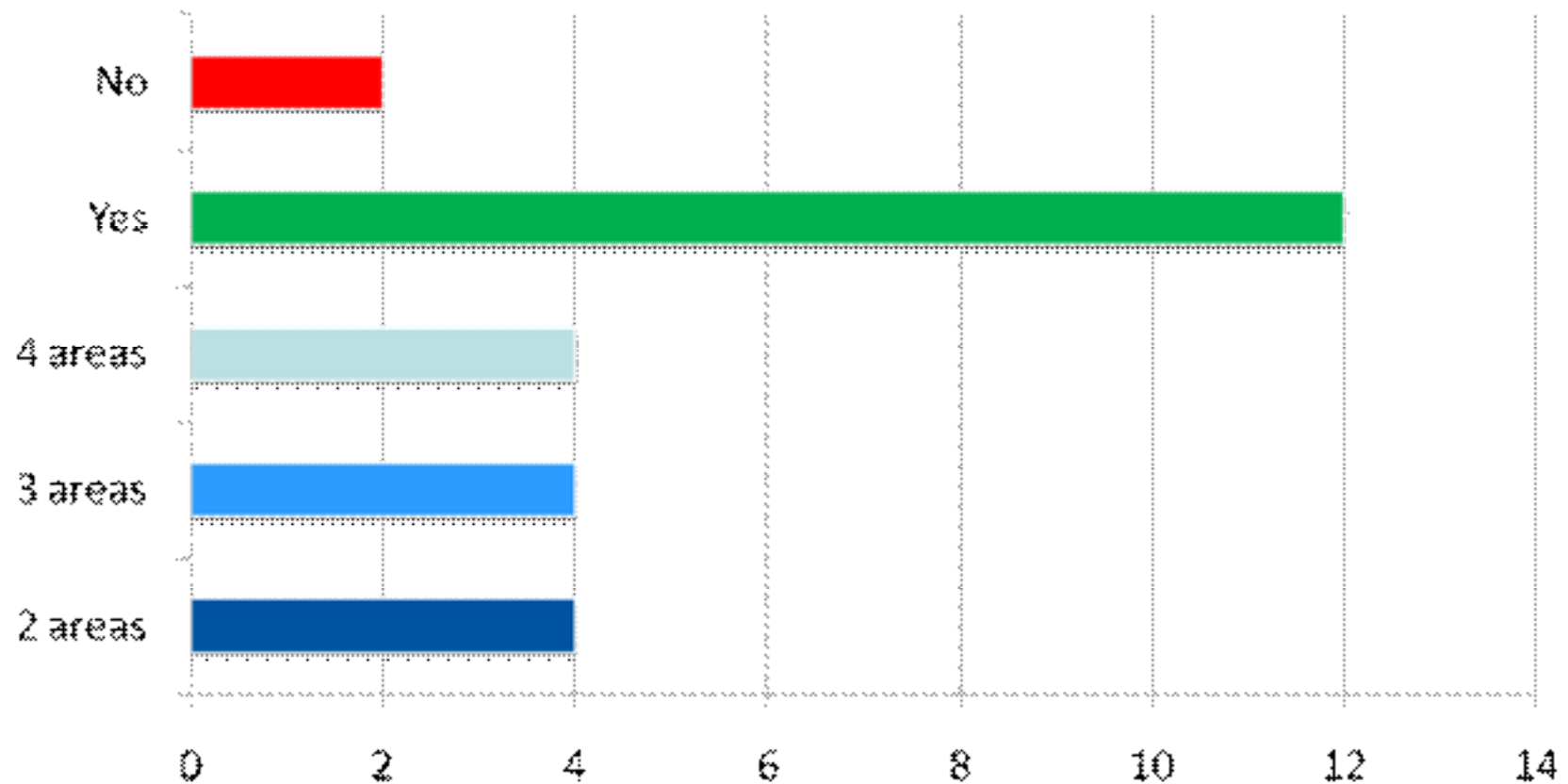

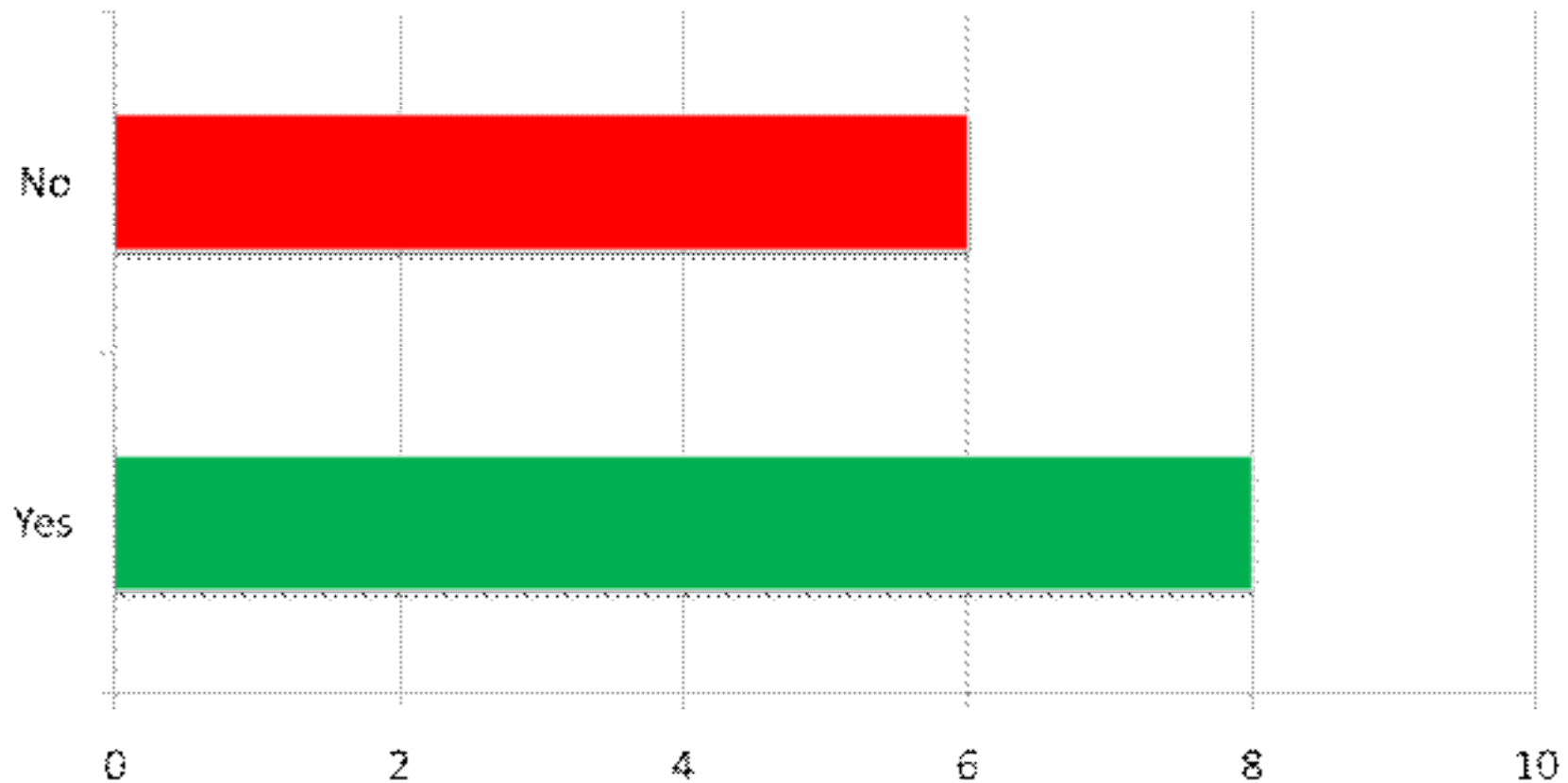
## Are different driving permits valid for different areas?

---

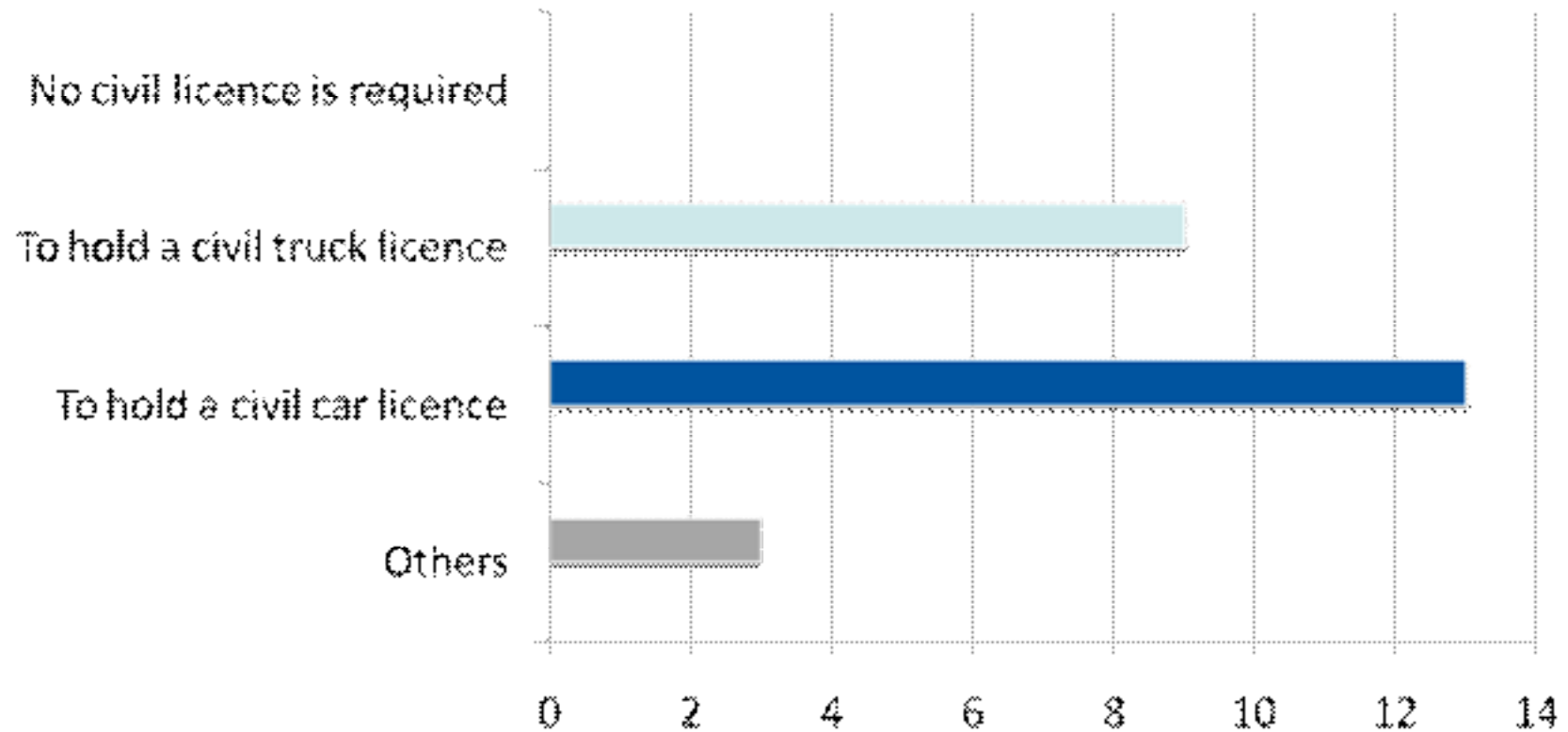


Are driving permits limited to drive specified vehicles or equipment?

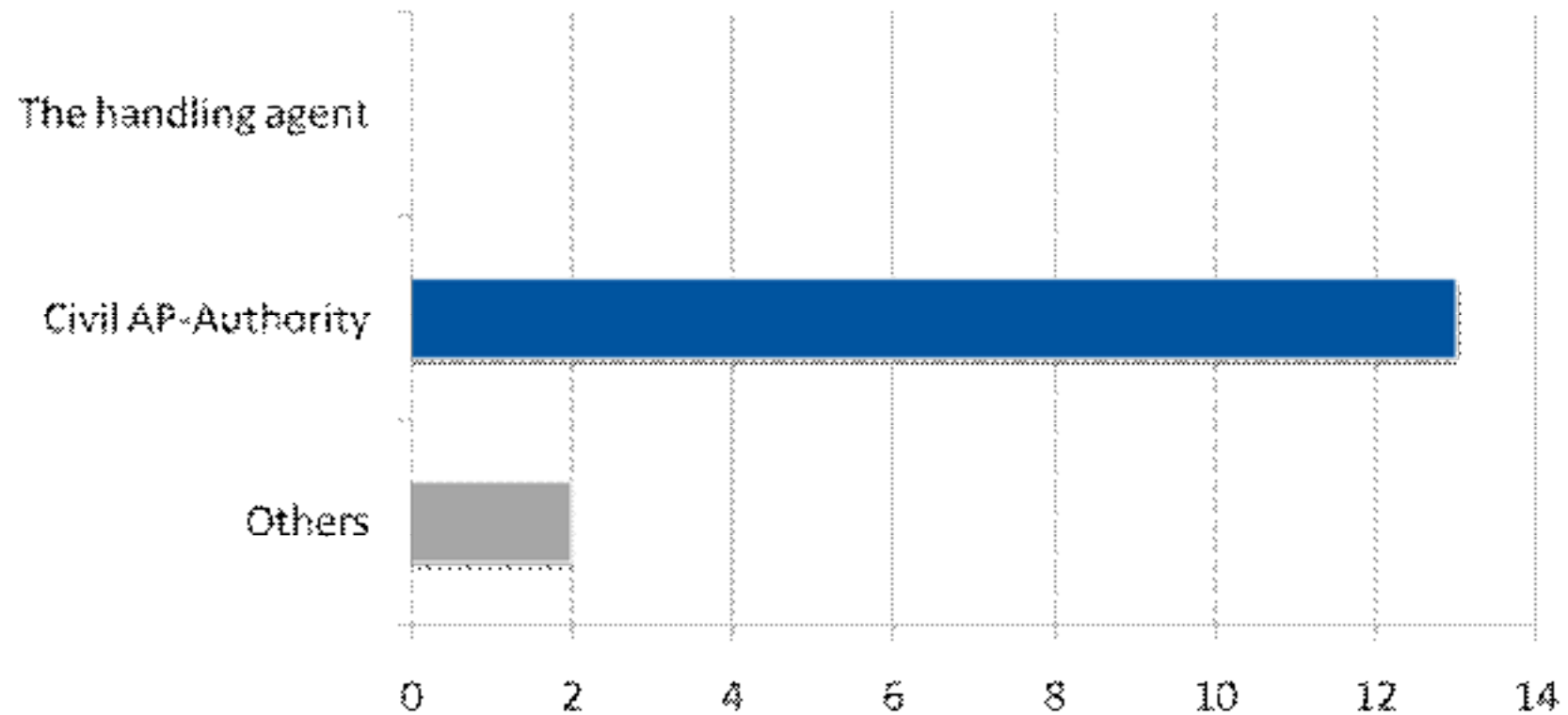


## Minimum requirements to obtain an airside driving permit?\*



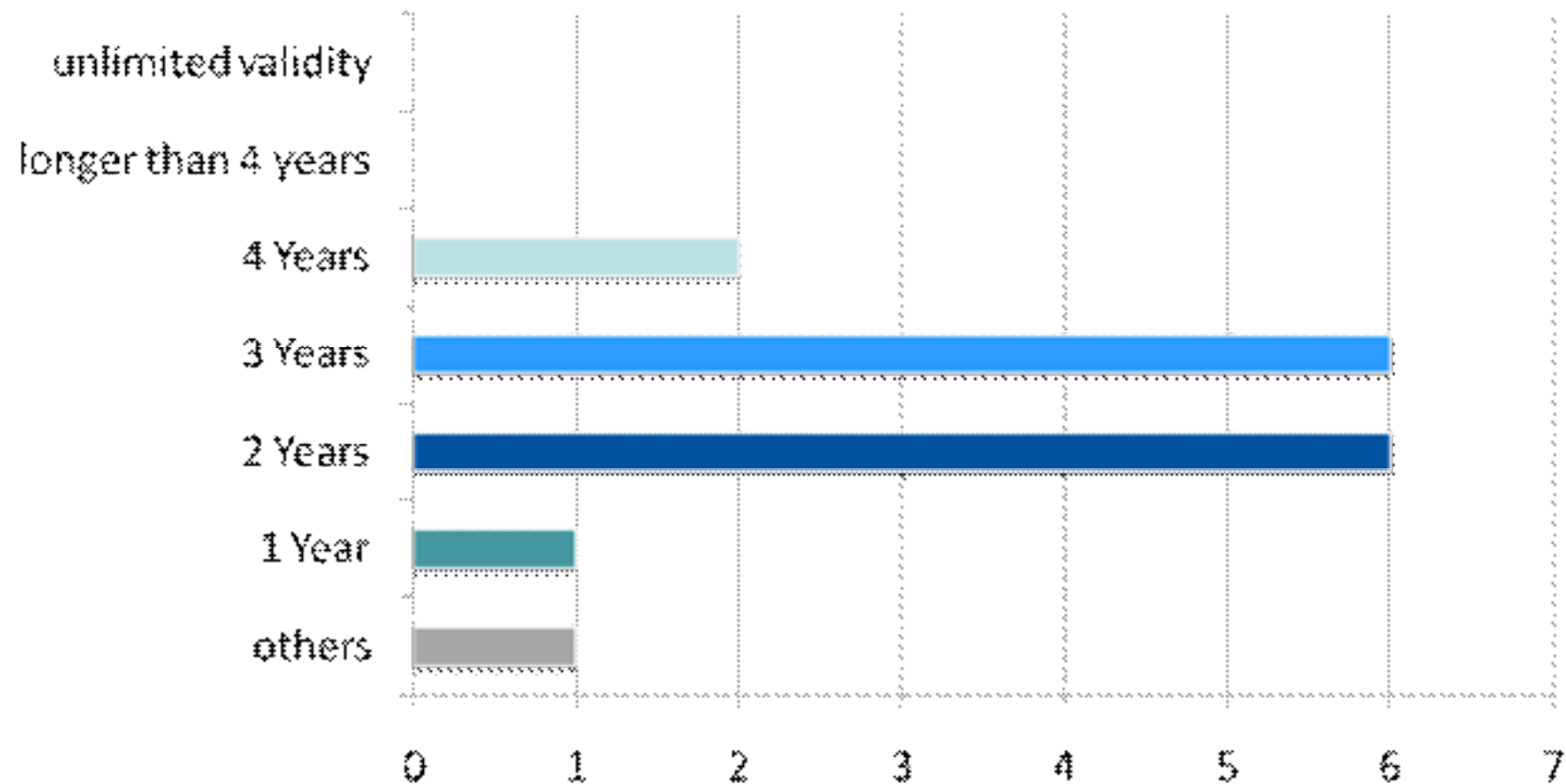

## Who issues the airport driving permit?\*



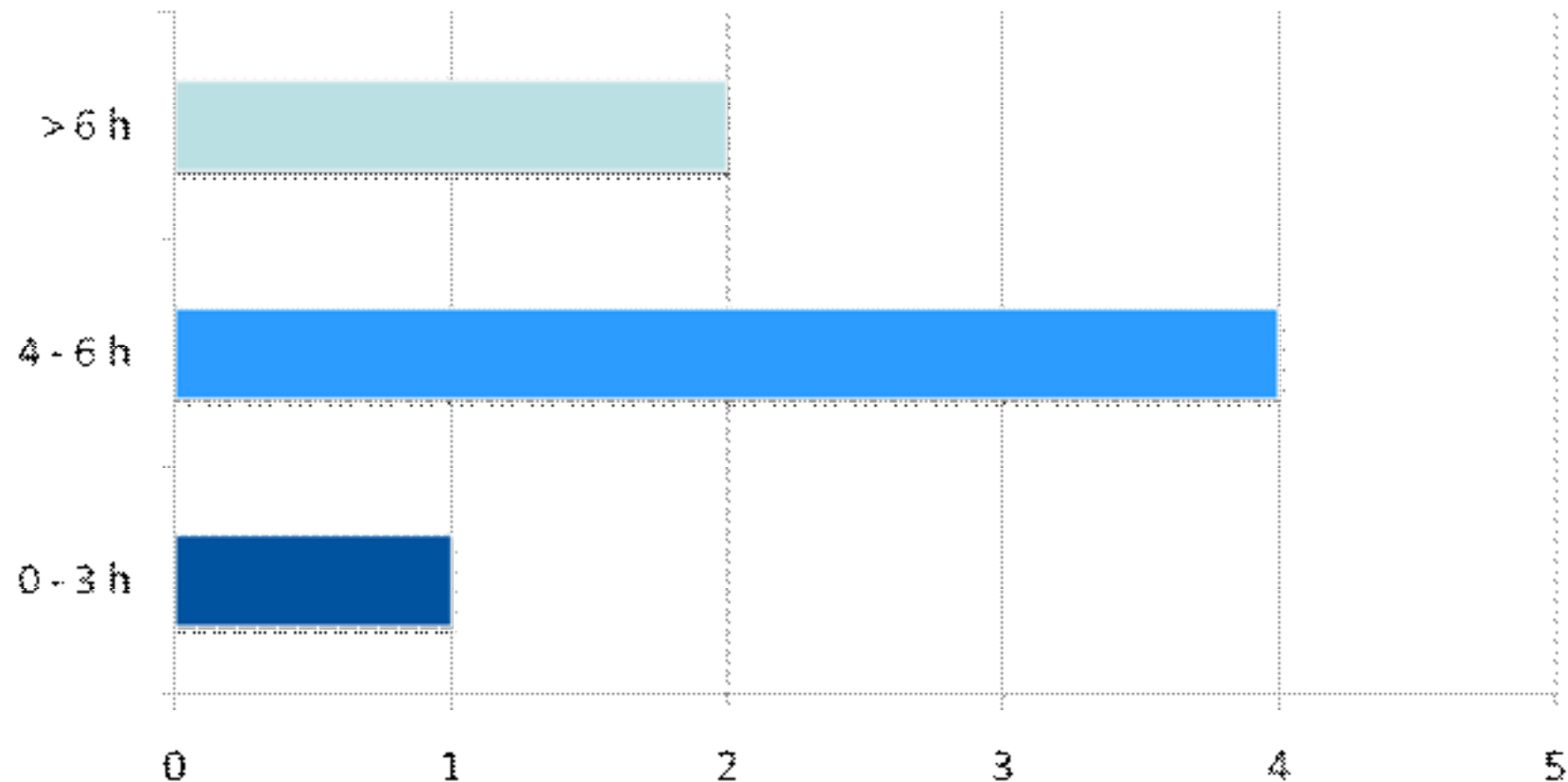

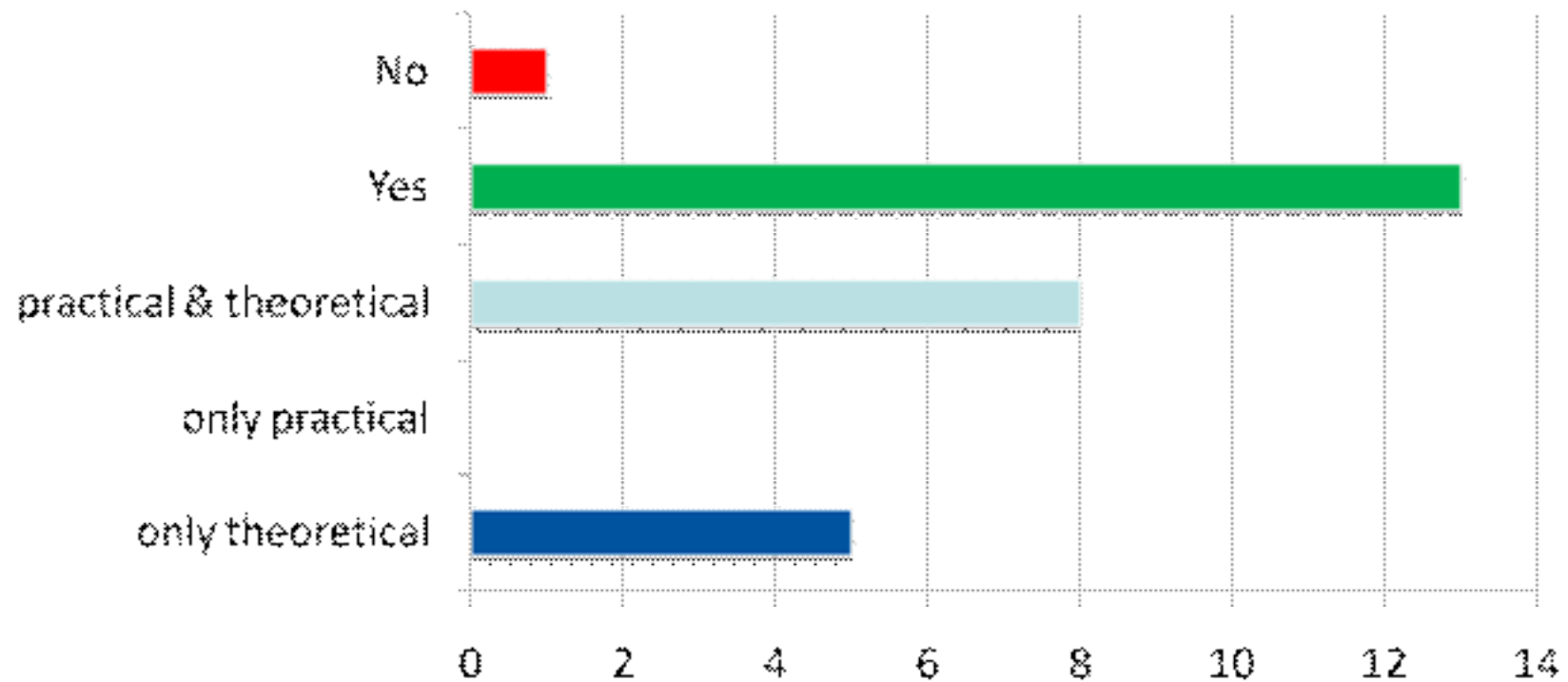

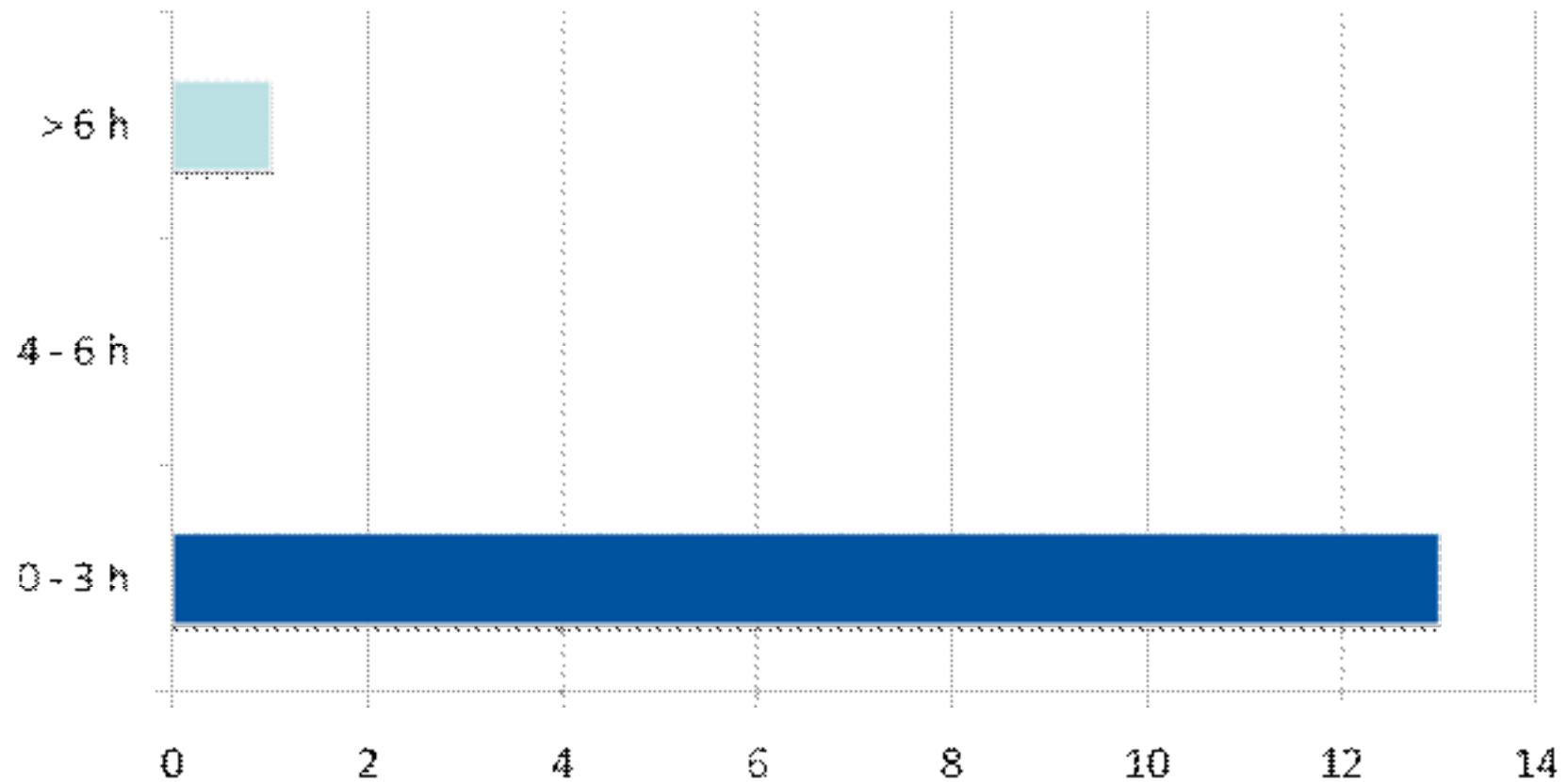

- AENA does not specify details for employees from other companies.

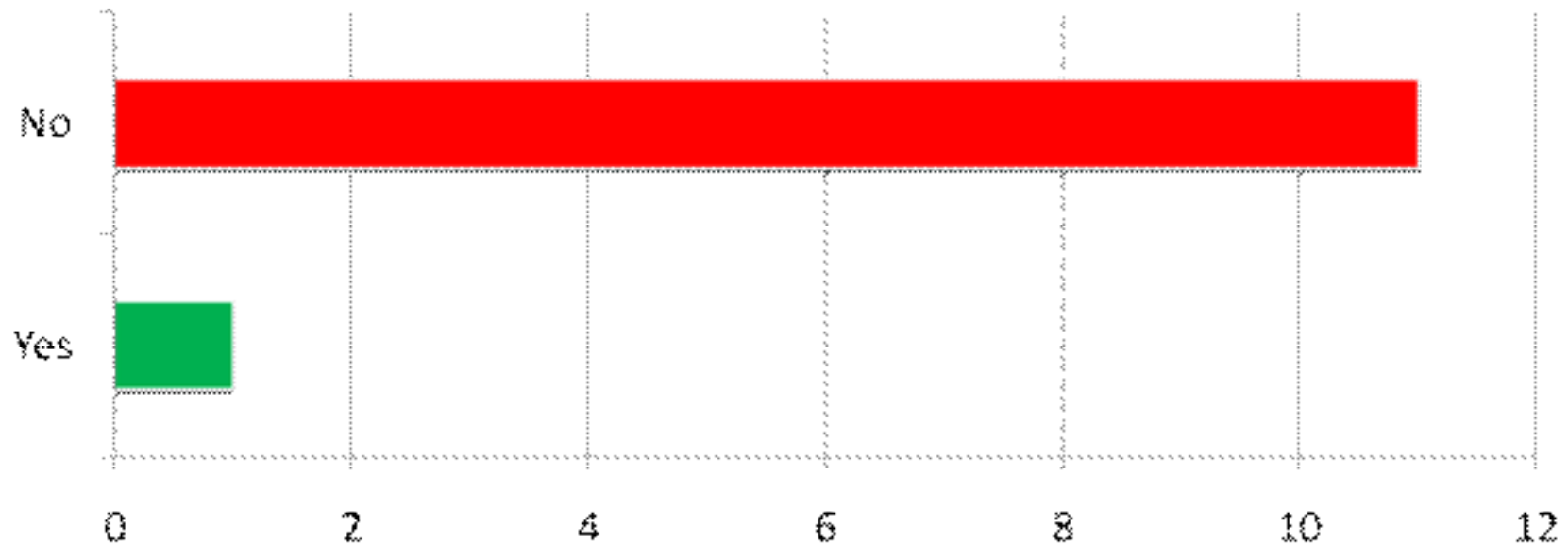
## Duration of final test?

## Are driving lessons/test free of charge?

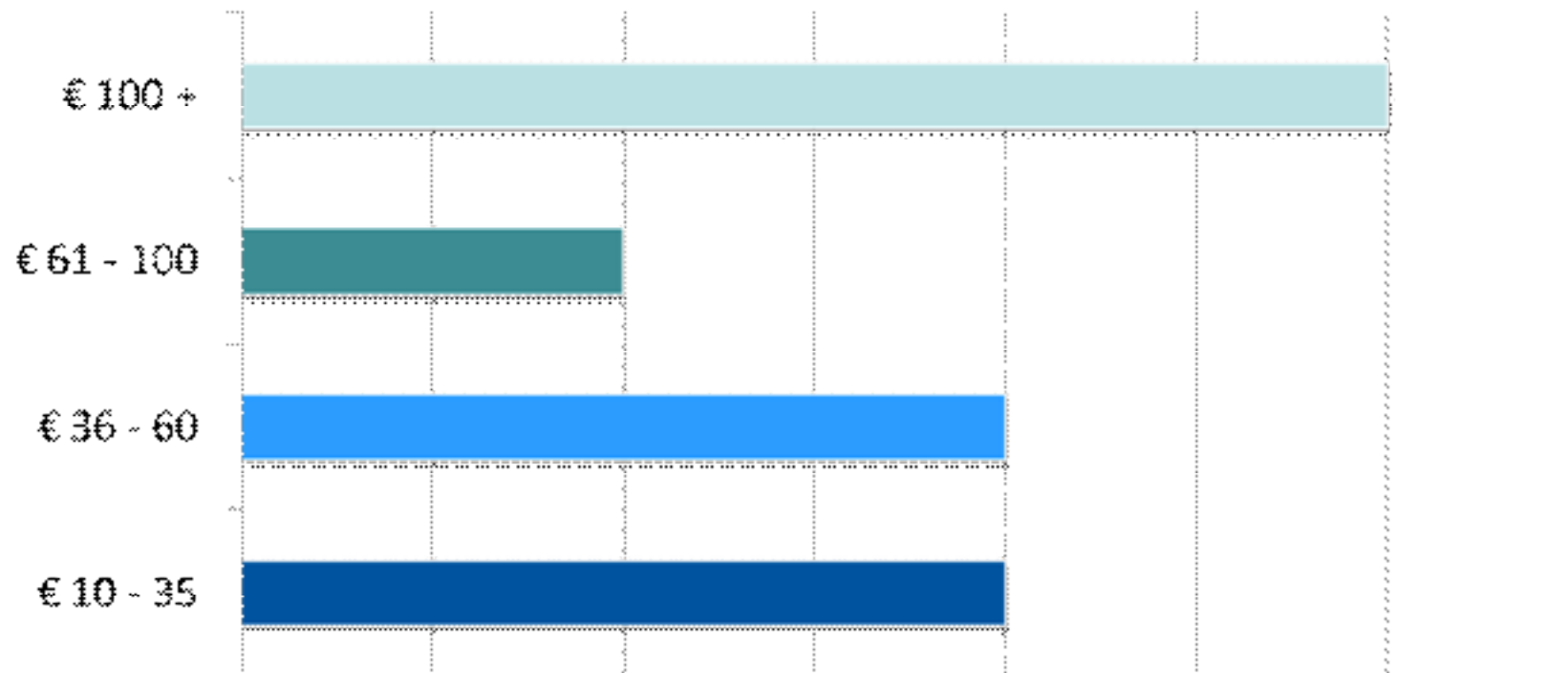

## Costs of driving lessons and test

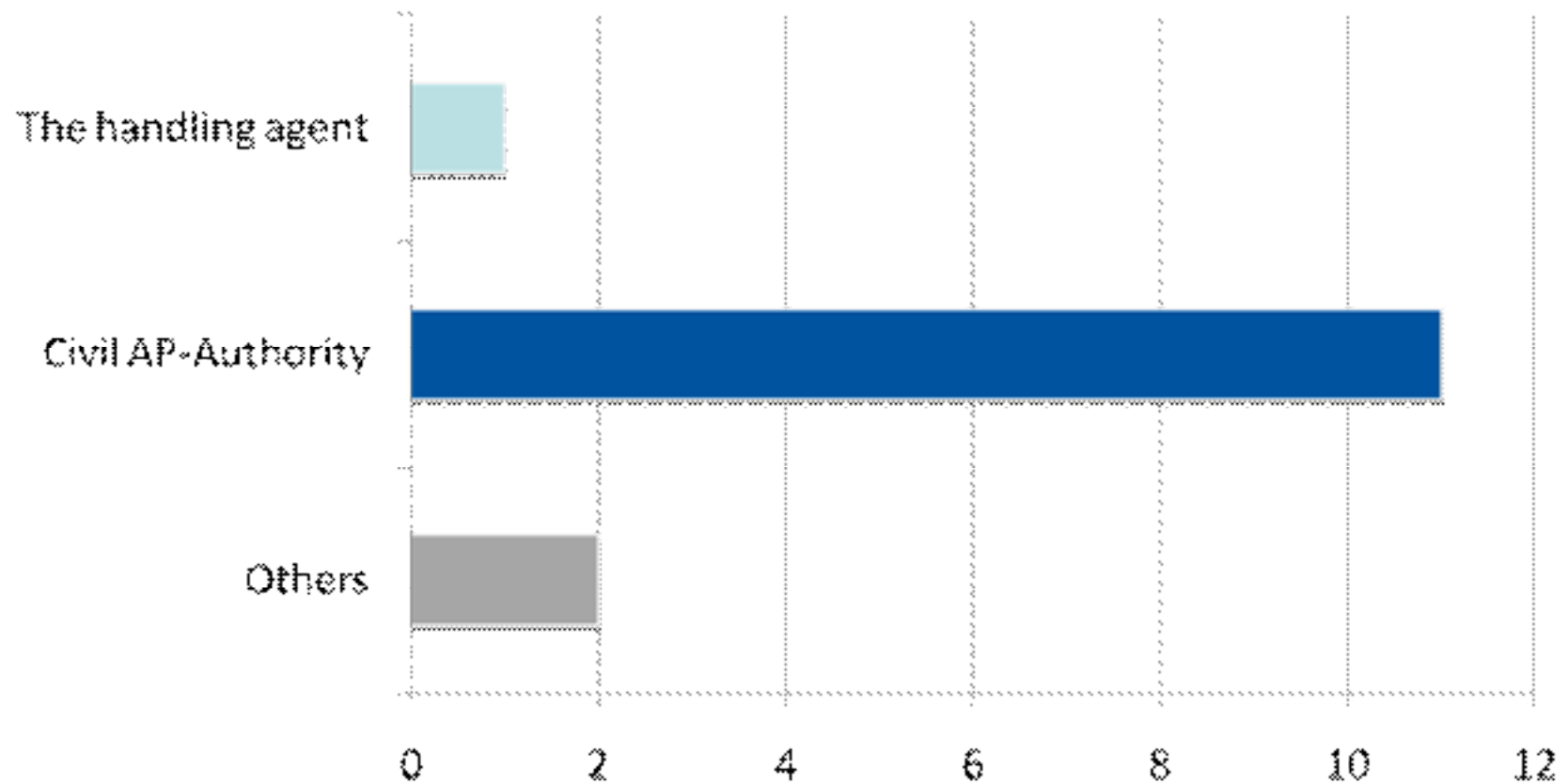

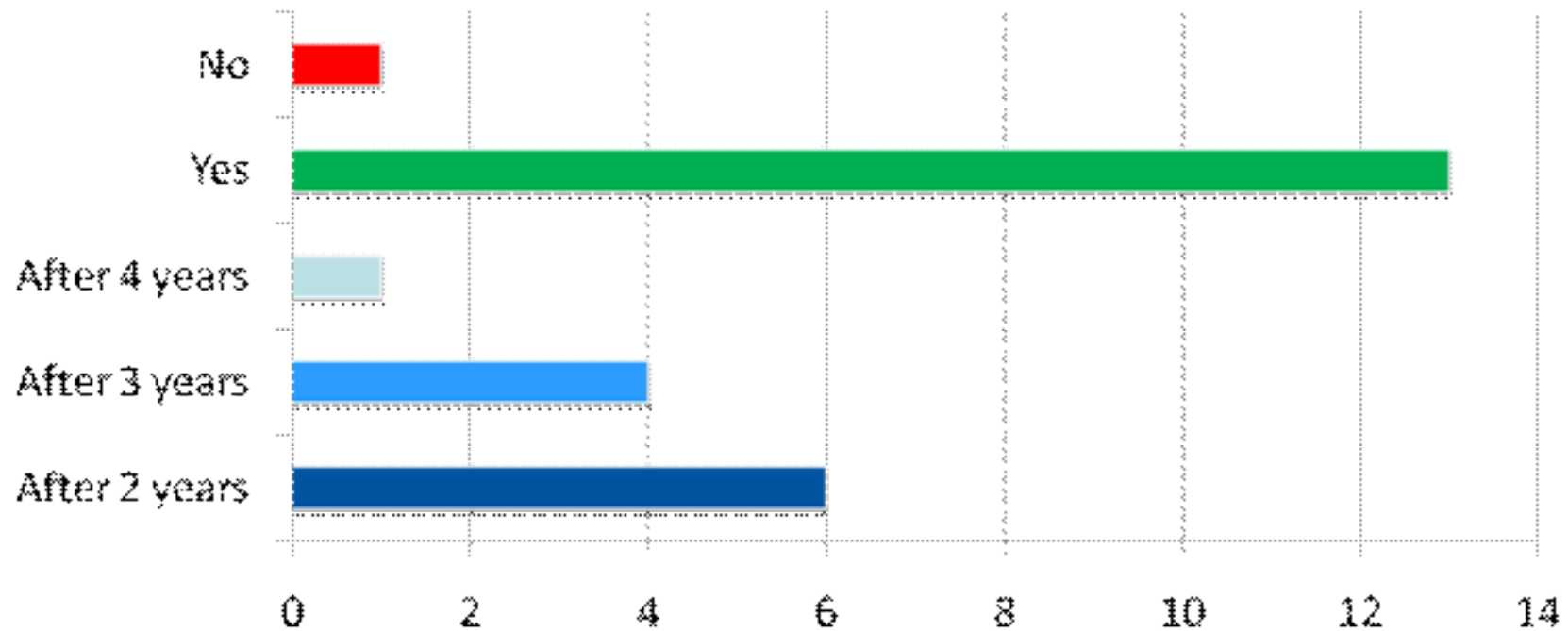
With costs up to € 296 is ZRH the most expensive airport.

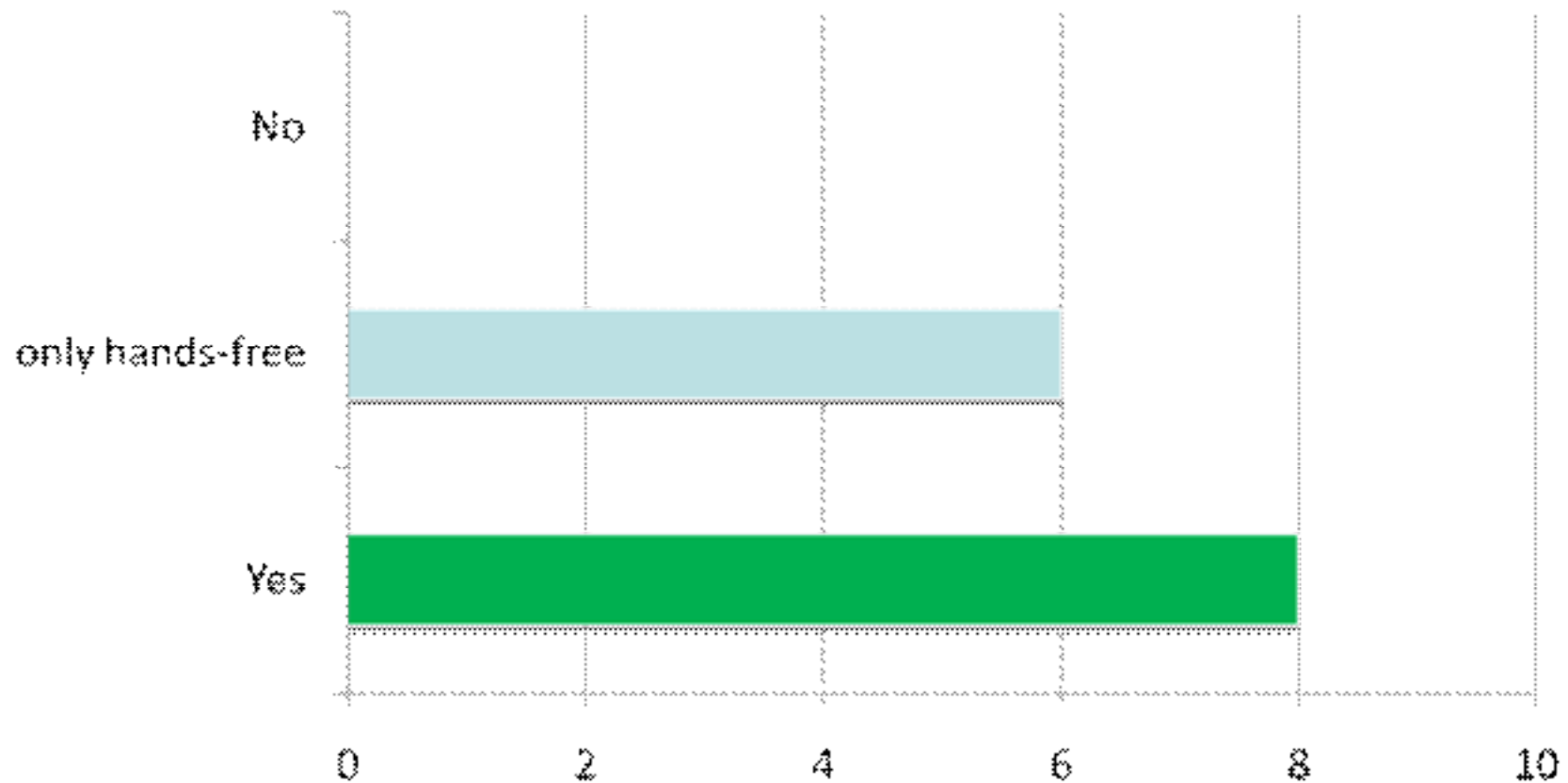


## Are refreshers conducted at regular intervals?



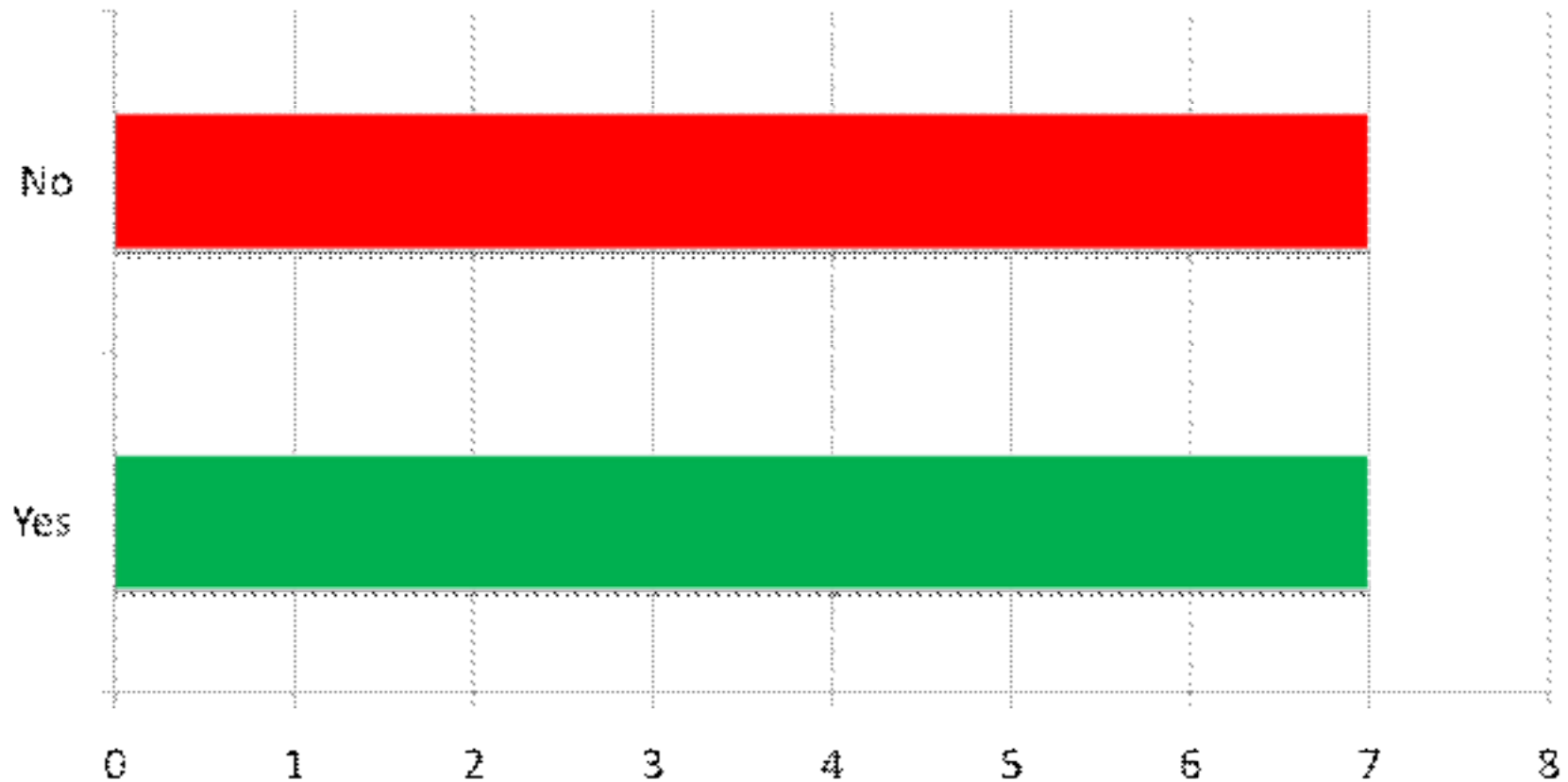
- BRU: 2 years: Maneuvering - 3 years: Apron

# Is the use of electronic equipment permitted while driving?

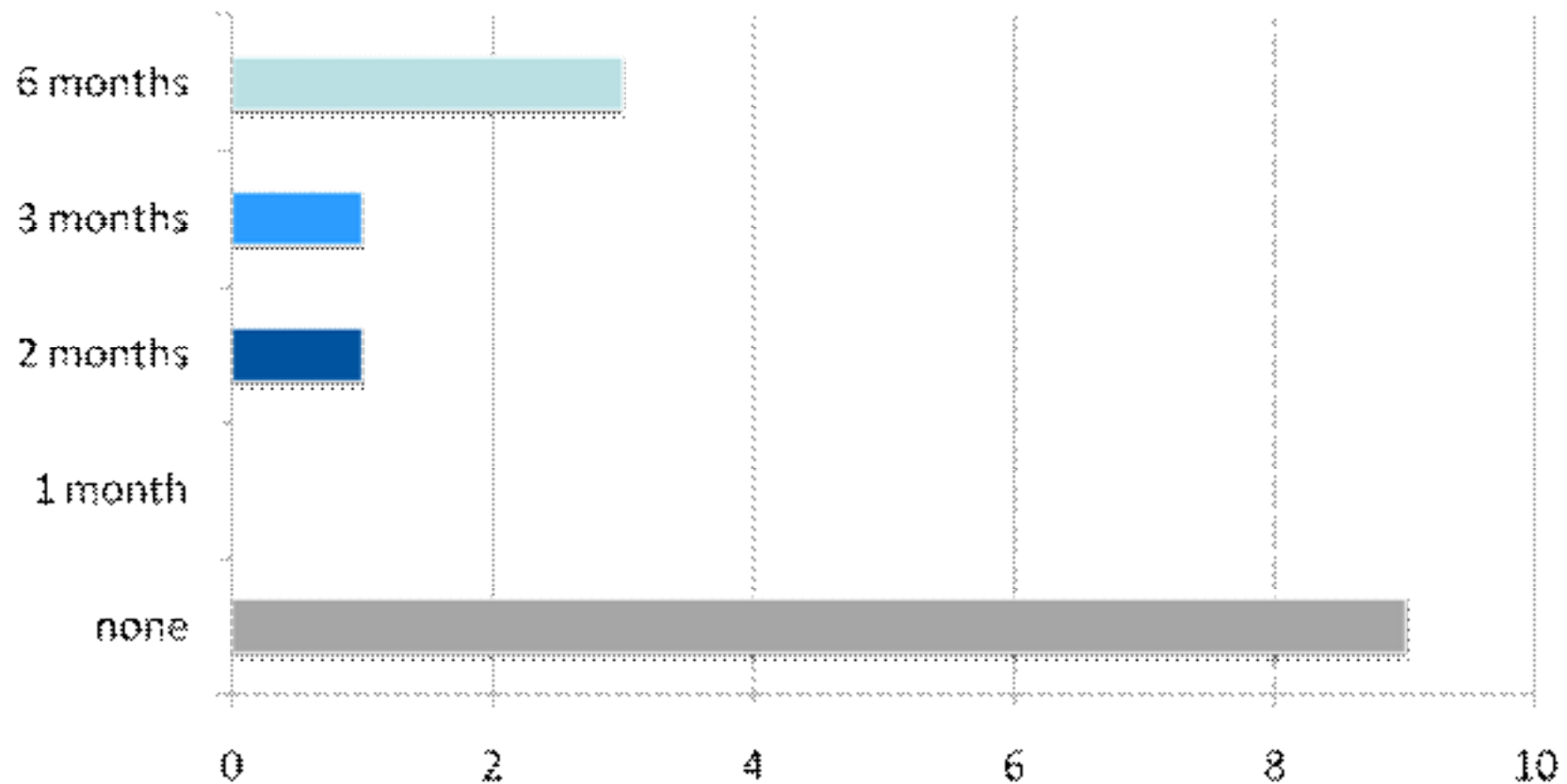


## Driver must be fluent in local or other required language

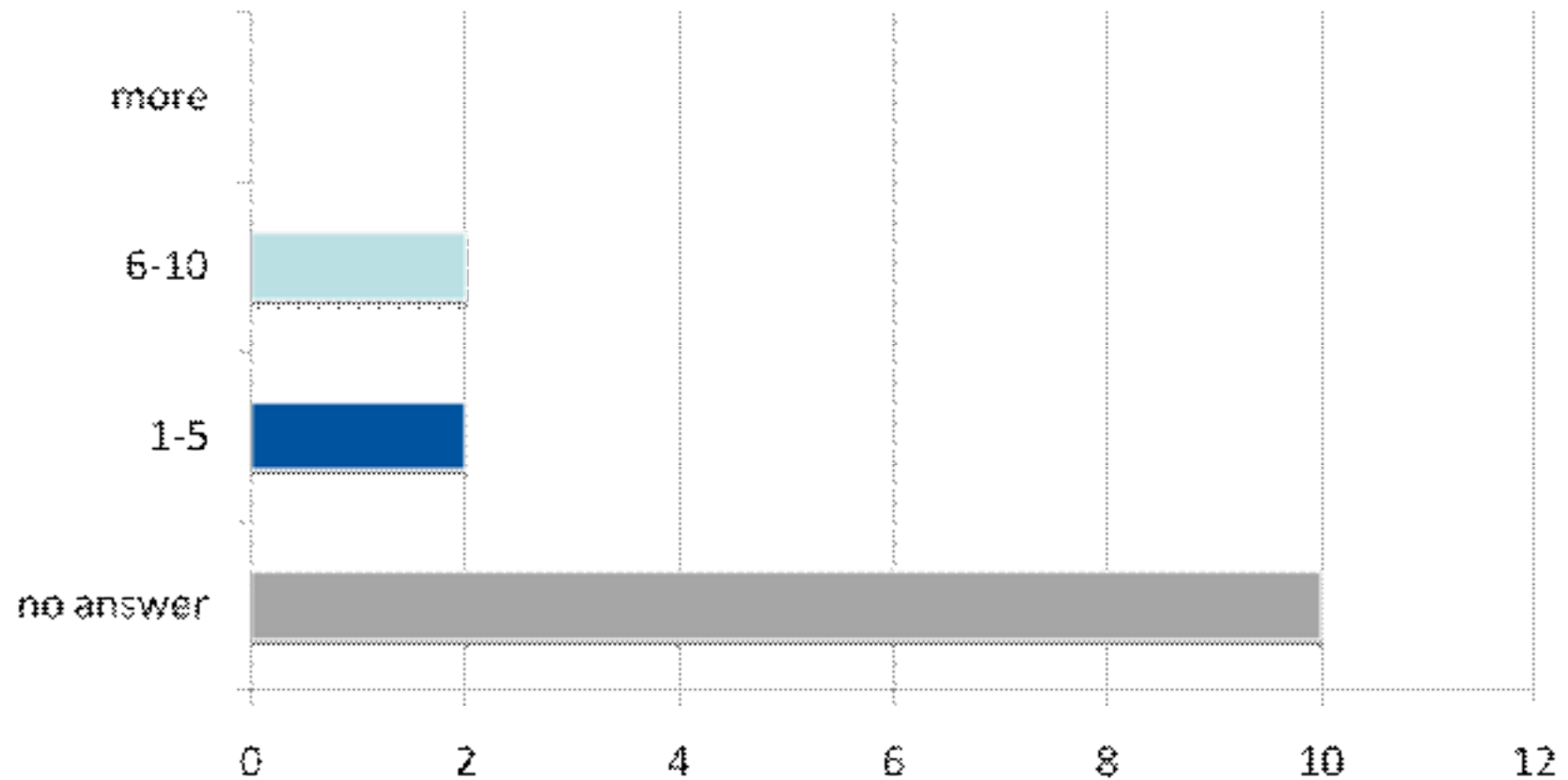

# Minimum duration of employment at airport

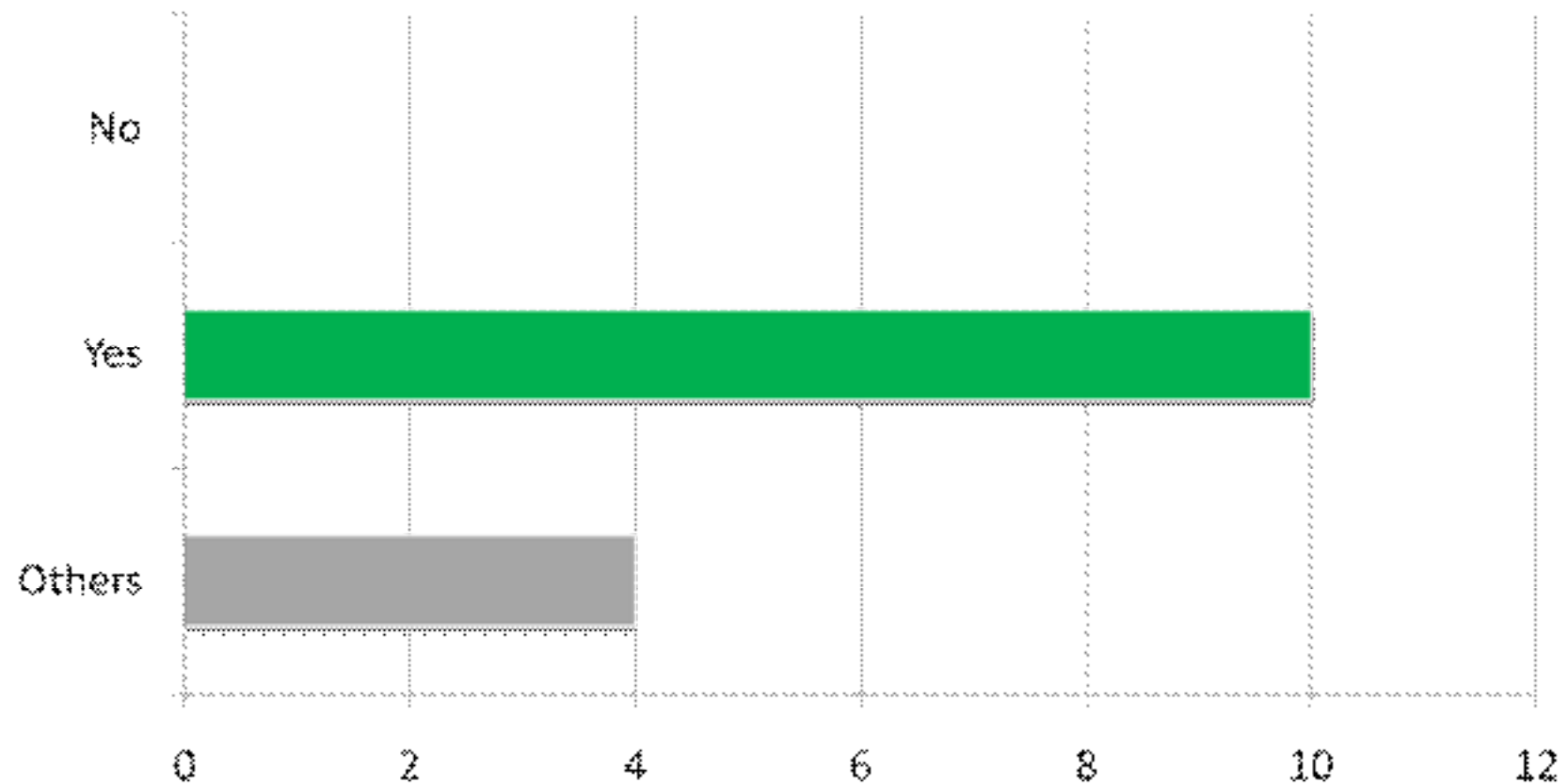


# Minimum use of a vehicle per month

## Summary of Findings

---

- All airports require specific driving permit for airside driving
- a civil car licence requirement
- validity of licence: 1-4 years; average 2 to 3 years.
- 90% of responding airports require a final test to pass.
- Use of electronic equipment generally permitted, 43% of the airports require hands-free equipment.
- In General, no minimum requirements of employment to apply for a driving licence
